

(JGP) .2 BackOffice: E-Commerce & Banking Agreement

This document outlines the professional standards, operational procedures, and financial terms for artists utilizing the Jgiggy Phynk (JGP) platform to distribute and monetize their music and video content.

1. Overview of the JGP Revenue Share Model

The Jgiggy Phynk Network provides an entertainment portal designed to serve as a high-visibility base for independent artists. By uploading content to the JGP portal, artists leverage our infrastructure to reach new audiences and monetize their self-published creative works.

The Partnership: JGP acts as the facilitator for your sales process. When an artist markets their music or video and directs traffic to their unique JGP portal link, JGP hosts the transaction.

Revenue Share: For every unit sold through the JGP portal, a 20% service fee is deducted from the gross price per transaction. This fee supports the maintenance, hosting, and secure processing of the JGP platform.

Net Payout: The remaining balance is remitted to the artist following the deduction of the JGP service fee.

2. Account Setup & Financial Integration

To ensure timely and accurate payouts, artists are required to complete the following setup:

Financial Configuration: Upon registering, artists must log in to the JGP Back Office and complete the "Financial Bank Payment Form." This form securely stores the banking information necessary for automated, accurate disbursement of earnings.

3. Sales Processing & Payout Schedule

JGP handles the end-to-end sales process, ensuring a seamless experience for your customers.

Automated Deduction: The 20% JGP service fee is automatically calculated and deducted at the point of sale.

Fast Payouts: Once the sale is authenticated, the remaining funds are processed and transmitted directly to the artist. Payouts are initiated immediately, with an expected

arrival time of 1 to 24 hours, depending on the processing speed of the artist's specific financial institution.

4. Ownership, Rights, and Content Management

Jgiggy Phynk operates as a distribution partner, not a record label or production company. We prioritize artist autonomy:

Artist Rights: By signing this agreement, artists consent to the promotion and sale of their content via the JGP portal. JGP claims no ownership over the artist's likeness, sound, music, or any associated intellectual property.

Independent Control: Artists retain full control over their catalog. You may remove your products from the JGP Back Office at any time without prior permission.

Re-posting Policy: Should an artist choose to remove content and subsequently wish to re-upload or re-post that content to the JGP portal, a nominal administrative fee of \$10.00 per song, video, or image set will be applied.

Artist Consent Agreement

By accessing the JGP Back Office and uploading content, the artist acknowledges they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms outlined above. The artist confirms they possess all necessary rights to the content being uploaded for sale and holds Jgiggy Phynk harmless regarding any copyright disputes arising from the artist's own publications.

These providers ensure that all customer payment data is encrypted and handled in compliance with global security standards (PCI-DSS).

Payout Methods: Artists can receive their net earnings (80% of gross sales) via their preferred method as configured in the JGP Back Office. Available options typically include direct bank deposit (ACH), digital wallet transfers (e.g., PayPal/Cash App), or wire transfer, depending on the artist's region and banking setup.

6. Technical Support & Troubleshooting

The JGP portal is designed for ease of use. However, should artists encounter difficulties, the following resources are available:

A. Upload Guidelines

To ensure content is processed correctly, all uploads must adhere to these standards:

File Formats: Music should be uploaded in high-quality .MP3 or .WAV format. Videos should be provided as .MP4 files.

Metadata: Artists are responsible for providing accurate titles, artwork, and descriptions to ensure their product is searchable and professional.

Submission Review: All uploads are subject to a brief technical review to ensure file integrity and compatibility with the JGP streaming portal.

B. Troubleshooting & Help Desk

If an artist experiences issues, they should follow these steps:

Check the FAQ: Visit the "Help" tab in the JGP Back Office for solutions to common questions regarding uploads, royalty tracking, and payout status.

Submit a Support Ticket: If the issue persists, artists may submit a ticket through the Support Portal in their dashboard. Please include your Artist ID, the name of the file in question, and a detailed description of the error.

Support Response Time: Our technical team aims to resolve all standard inquiries within 24–48 hours.

C. Content Management (The \$10.00 Re-post Fee)

As noted, artists may remove their content at any time. If an artist chooses to re-post content that was previously removed, they must process the \$10.00 Administrative Re-activation Fee per item within the Back Office. This fee covers the manual system processing and re-indexing of the content into the JGP store.

[] Create Account: Register and verify email.

[] Marketing: Use your unique JGP portal link to drive traffic to your music/videos.

Part 2: Product Upload Portal (JGP Back Office)

This form allows artists to upload their music/video products. The "hidden" fields are used by the system to track the revenue split logic.

Part 3: Implementing the "Automatic Split" (Conceptual Guide)

To achieve the automatic deduction and payout process, you cannot rely on HTML alone. You must implement Split Payments via a Payment Service Provider (PSP) API.

How to implement the logic:

Integration with Stripe Connect:

When an artist signs up, use the "Stripe Connect" API to create a Connected Account for them.

When a customer buys a song for \$10.00:

Your application logic triggers a "Destination Charge."

The transaction is split instantly: \$2.00 (20%) is sent to your JGP business account, and \$8.00 (80%) is sent to the artist's Stripe-connected bank account.

Payout Speed:

By using an "Instant Payout" feature within these platforms, the funds reach the artist's bank account or digital debit card within the 1-24 hour window as specified in your business model.

Best Practices for Your Portal:

Security (SSL/TLS): Ensure your entire JGP website is served over HTTPS to protect the banking data submitted in the forms.

Data Minimization: Do not store full bank account numbers on your own server. Use the "tokenization" provided by your payment processor (e.g., Stripe, PayPal, or Square) so that sensitive data is stored in their secure vaults, not yours.

Audit Trail: In your back-office "Earnings" tab, ensure the code generates a downloadable CSV report for the artist, showing: Total Sales -> Minus 20% Fee -> Net Amount Paid. This maintains the transparency required for professional artist partnerships.
